# Horticultural Project Exhibit



4H is a community of young people who are learning leadership citizenship and life skills.

The Horticultural Project Exhibit is a "how-to" type project that allows you to look at the steps involved in completing a horticulture task from beginning to end and documenting the procedure along the way.

Choose a "how-to" horticulture project. The following are a list of examples, but projects are not limited to these five.

- How to propagate plants
- How to force spring bulbs
- How to start seeds
- How to graft cacti
- How to dry herbs

A one-page project description and tri-fold project board are required for this project. The project description and project board should be easy to understand and informative to the viewer, and include the following:

- Title of the project (the title should tell the viewer quickly about the experiment)
- Statement about what is to be accomplished from the experiment
- Description of materials used to complete the project
- Description of procedures used to complete the project
- Results and conclusion of your project including (but not limited to): statements by individuals, a timeline of photographs of the project, examples of what the project accomplished.
- One-page description of the project (typed or printed neatly), stapled to the board or in a folder.
